## Day 1: NJP Railway station / IXB (Bagdogra airport) to Gangtok Transfer - 31st,

May 2024

Night stay: Gangtok

• Upon your arrival at NJP (New Jalpaiguri) Railway Station or IXB (Bagdogra Airport), you'll be greeted by your tour guide/driver. • Begin your journey towards Gangtok, the capital city of Sikkim. Excursion - 1st, Jun 2024

Night stay: Gangtok

• Early in the morning, after breakfast, prepare for a full-day excursion to Changu Lake (also known as Tsomgo Lake), Baba Mandir, and Nathula Pass. • Depart from your hotel in Gangtok and embark on the scenic drive towards Changu Lake, which is located approximately 40 kilometers from Gangtok. • Changu Lake is a glacial lake situated at an altitude of 12,313 feet. Enjoy the breathtaking views of the surrounding snow-capped mountains and the pristine blue waters of the lake. • Depending on the season, you might get the chance to experience activities like yak rides or snow play at Changu Lake (subject to availability). • After spending some time at Changu Lake, continue your journey towards Baba Mandir, which is dedicated to BabaHarbhajan Singh, a revered soldier of the Indian Army. • Pay your respects at the shrine andlearn about the fascinating stories and legends associated with Baba Harbhajan Singh. • FromBaba Mandir, proceed towards Nathula Pass, a mountain pass situated at an altitude of 14,140feet and a part of the ancient Silk Route connecting India and Tibet. • Nathula Pass offersstunning panoramic views of the Himalayas and is also a strategic border crossing between Indiaand China. • Spend some time at Nathula Pass, exploring the area and soaking in thebreathtaking scenery. • Please note that Nathula Pass is subject to availability and permits from the authorities. It's advisable to check the current status and obtain necessary permits inadvance. • After exploring Nathula Pass, start your journey back to Gangtok. • Return to yourhotel in Gangtok by the evening and relax after a day of adventure and sightseeing. • In theevening, you can explore the local markets or indulge in some delicious Sikkimese cuisine. •Overnight stay in Gangtok.

Take a joyride on this UNESCO World Heritage narrow-gauge railway from Darjeeling station to Ghum, the highest railway station in India. Marvel at the engineering marvels and scenic vistas along the route. • Conclude your sightseeing tour with a visit to the Peace Pagoda, a serene Buddhiststupa offering panoramic views of Darjeeling town and the surrounding mountains.
