8 Nights & 9 Days | Destinations : Kargil (1 night) Leh (2 nights) Nubra Valley (3 nights) Pangong Lake (1 night) Tso Moriri (1 night)



Day 1: Srinagar - Kargil via Sonmarg - 28th, May 2024

Night stay: Kargil

After breakfast drive to Kargil, enroute stops include Sonamarg and Baltal hamlets, famous for rugged snow peaked meadows. Past Baltal cross over Zoji-La Pass (11,500 ft). We are in Drass valley with strikingly different landscape dotted with remote mud huts giving an impression that you really have traveled back in time. After a passport check (not for Indian Citizen) we continue on to Kargil. Dinner and overnight at Hotel. ZOJILA PASS: Zojila is one of the high motorable pass at an altitude of 3505 meters. Zojila is on Leh-Srinagar highway, 127 Kms from Srinagarand 307 Kms from Leh built by Indian Army. Zojila pass closes during the winter due to heavysnowfall and cleared every summer for passage of Army and civil vehicles. DRASS: It is the firstmajor village on the route Kashmir to Kargil, inhabited by a population of mixed Kashmiri andDard origins, has the local reputation of being the second coldest permanently inhabited spot inthe world. But in summer when the pass is open and the tourist are going through, the standingcrops and clumps of willow give it a gentle, smiling look. The Kargil War Memorial (SundayClose), also known as Dras War Memorial, is a war memorial built by the Indian Army in the townof Dras, commemorating the 1999 Kargil War between India and Pakistan. The memorial islocated on the Srinagar-Leh National Highway 1D, about 5 km from the city centre across the Tiger Hill.

Day 2: Kargil - Leh via Lamayuru - 29th, May 2024

Night stay: Leh

Today after an early breakfast, check-out and drive to Leh. En-route visiting Mulbekh, Lamayuru Monastery, Magnetic Hill, Gurudwara Patthar Sahib, Confluence of Zanskar and Indus river and Ladakh Hall of Fame. Reach Leh in the evening. Dinner and overnight stay. MULBEKH GOMPA: Precariously perched a top of a 200 Mts. high crag, it has an imposing rock-carving of Chamba, the future Buddha. On the other end of the valley is a large vertical phallus shaped rock with a monastery at its base. LAMAYURU GOMPA: The oldest holy site in Ladakh, it was a bon shrine prior to the advent of Buddhism. Also known as Yung Drung (Swastika) it is sited on a high promontory overlooking the village and valley. For sheer spectacle value no other Gompa can match Lamayuru. MAGNETIC HILL: Defying the Law of gravity. This place is close to the Gurdwara Shri Patthar Sahib. It has been noticed that when a vehicle is parked on neutral gear on this metallic road the vehicle slides up-hill that's the Believe it or not of Ladakh! GURDWARA SHRI PATTHAR SAHIB: The Shrine known as Gurdwara Patthar sahib is situated about 25 kms. Short of Leh town on the Leh-Srinagar road. Built in the everlasting memory of Shri Guru Nanak Deve Ji the great prophet who sanctified the place by his sacred visit during theyear 1517 while on his second missionary tour (2nd Udassi 1515-1518). The boulder havingimprint of the Guru's back is lying in the Gurdwara to this day. CONFLENCE OF THEZANSKAR & INDUS: On way to Sham Valley before Nimu village one can have this magnificentview of two rivers in wed-lock! In seasons they have different colors and flow and wildness.LADAKH HALL OF FAME (Monday Close): The Hall of Fame is a glorious museum constructed by the Indian Army. It is worth a visit for every citizen. You can see the memorabilia, eminentdefense personalities with biographies, images and weapons used during the Kargil and otherkey strategic battles fought in Ladakh. And belongings of the enemy soldiers found at war site. All the martyr and the gallantry awards. "Here's something that you will be proud of oudefense personnel who sacrificed themselves so that we could live in peace.―

Day 3: Leh - Nubra via Khardungla Pass - 30th, May 2024

Night stay: Nubra Valley

Early morning proceed to Nubra Valley via the World Highest Motorable road (5602 Mts) Khardungla pass. Arrive Nubra and proceed for a visit to the White Sand Dunes at Hunder. You can enjoy the camel ride (at your own). Later if time permits visit Hunder and Deskit monasteries and check in at Deluxe Camp/Hotel. Evening at leisure. Overnight Dinner & Stay.KHARDUNGLA PASS: The road journey to Nubra valley leads through Khardung La pass (Thehighest Motorable road in the world) 18,390 ft. around 39 Kms. Away from Leh. There are twocheckpoints on the both sides of the pass. Khardong is the first village of Nubra valley at higheraltitude than Deskit and other villages. DESKIT GOMPA: Deskit Gompa was founded by LamaSherab Zangpo of Stod in about 1420 AD during the reign of King Dragspa. About 100 monksare residing in the Gompa, which is a branch of Thikse Monastery. The monastic festival calledGustor takes place on 20th and 21st days of the 12th month of Tibetan calendar. Deskit is themain village of headquarter of Nubra valley, which has a small market consisting of a row ofshops and about 500 years old Gompa on the hilltop. Spectacular view of the valley can be seenform the monastery. HUNDAR VILLAGE: Hundar is a beautiful village to stay with lot of trees andyou will really enjoy your stay at Hundar. It has a small monastery and ruined fort above thevillage. The walk or Camel Safari (Double Hump bacterian camels) from Hundar to Deskit, through sand dunes is wonderful (at your own). MAITREYA BUDDHA: The 108 feet tall statue of Maitreya Buddha is located just below the Diskit monastery, at an altitude of 10,308 feet, 15kilometers northwest off the Khalsar-Panakil route, right at the edge of the desert in the NubraValley.

Day 4: : Excursion to Turtuk - 31st, May 2024

Night stay: Nubra Valley

After Breakfast drive to Turtuk, after sightseeing drive to Nubra, Overnight at Hotel. Turtuk is a village in the Leh district of Jammu and Kashmir, India. It is located in the Nubra tehsil, 205 km from the Leh town, on the banks of the Shyok River. Turtuk gram panchayat is the northernmost village of India. Turtuk was under Pakistan's control until 1971, after which India gained control of this strategic area. It is predominantly a Muslim village, and residents speak languages including Balti, Ladakhi and Urdu. Turtuk is the last outpost in India after which the Pakistan-controlled Gilgit-Baltistan begins. Turtuk is one of the gateways to the Siachen Glacier

Day 5: Siachen Base Camp - 1st, Jun 2024

Night stay: Nubra Valley

After breakfast drive to Siachen Glacier enroute can visit Sumur (visit the 150 year old Samstanling Gompa It is one of the prettiest sights in the valley. The main attraction of the village is the Samstanling Gompa, located above the village at the foot of barren mountains and next stop is Panamik hot spring (Panamik has a natural hot water spring. There is a bath which has the facilities so that you can take bath in the natural hot water spring and continue to visitSasoma village and you will reach base camp by afternoon and explore the beauty of SiachenGlacier (The Siachen Glacier at the height of around 20,000 ft in the Karakoram range is knownas the highest militarised zone in the world) and then drive back to nubra. Overnight stay inCamp.

Day 6: Nubra - Pangong - 2nd, Jun 2024

Night stay: Pangong Lake

Morning after Breakfast proceed for Pangong. After reach check-in at camp. Evening relax, Dinner & Overnight at tent. THE PANGONG LAKE: This route takes the visitor past the picturesque villages and turns off the Indus valley by the side valley of Chemrey and Sakti. The Ladakh range is crossed by the Chang-la (18,000 feet / 5,475 M) which despite its great elevation is one of the easier passes, remaining open for much of the year even in winter, apart from periods of actual snowfall. The main attraction of this circuit is the Pangong Lake, situated at 14,000 feet (4,267 M). A long narrow basin of inland drainage, hardly six to seven kilometers at its widest point to which foreigners are permitted, is only some seven km along the southern shore from the head of the lake, but it affords spectacular views of the mountains of the Changchenmo range to the north, their reflection shimmering in the ever-changing blues and greens of the lakes brackish water. Above Spangmik are the glacier and snow-capped peaks of the Pangong range.

Day 7: Pangong - Tsomoriri - 3rd, Jun 2024

Night stay: Tso Moriri

After breakfast drive for Tsomo-riri Lake (alt: 15,000 ft.) driving through Mahe Bridge. Tsomoriri Lake (28 km long & about 8 km wide) is the breeding ground of many migratory birds including the rare bar-headed geese. Dinner & overnight in fixed camp or Guest House. KORZOK, is situated at 15000 ft. (4572 M) with its dozen or so houses and its Gompa appearing like a mirage among the barren hills, is the only permanent settlement in Rupshu valley; otherwise the regionis inhabited only by nomadic Chang-pa herds people. The Rupshu Cang-pa lives in tents all the year round, moving in accordance with an old-established annual routine between the pastures that exist wherever an occasional stream carrying snowmelt from the heights makes possible the reportedly highly nutritious. The few barley fields at Korzok must be among the highest cultivation in the world, but there is no guarantee that the crop will ripen every year. TSOMORIRI LAKE:The area traversed by the Manali Leh road, and containing the drainage basins of Tsomoriri andother lakes is known as Rupshu. Here, the Zanskar range is transformed into bare rolling many-hued hills divided by open high altitude valleys scoured by dust-devils. It is a landscape quiteunlike any other in Ladakh- or elsewhere in India.

Day 8: Tsomoriri - Leh - 4th, Jun 2024

Night stay: Leh

After breakfast drive Leh via visit Tsokar Lake, a salt lake system in the Rupsho plateau which is home of the Changa nomads and support many rare wild life species. After sightseeing of the area take the Manali-Leh road to return to Leh. Arrive hotel in Leh for dinner and overnight. TSOKAR: Tsokar Lake is approximately 45 kms northwest of the Tsomoriri Lake at a height of 4485 m. It is also called "White Lake" because of salt deposited around it. Since these are all drainage basins with no outlet their water is brackish. The water of Tsokar is so salty that salt is procured from its banks and sold all over Ladakh and Kashmir by the Rupsu Chang. Tsokar is partly fade by a channel from a smaller fresh water lake. All the lakes are breeding grounds for a variety of birds among them the bar-headed goose, the great crested grebe, the brahmin duck and the brown headed gull.
