It costs approximately 100 INR to 450 INR per person Rajamalai Eravikulam National Park: See Nilgiri Thar - an endangered species of mountain goats, rolling grasslands and sholas, spread over 97 sq km in the Rajamalai hills, rare flora and fauna, Atlas moth (largest in the world), The entry fees are approximately 60 INR per person
